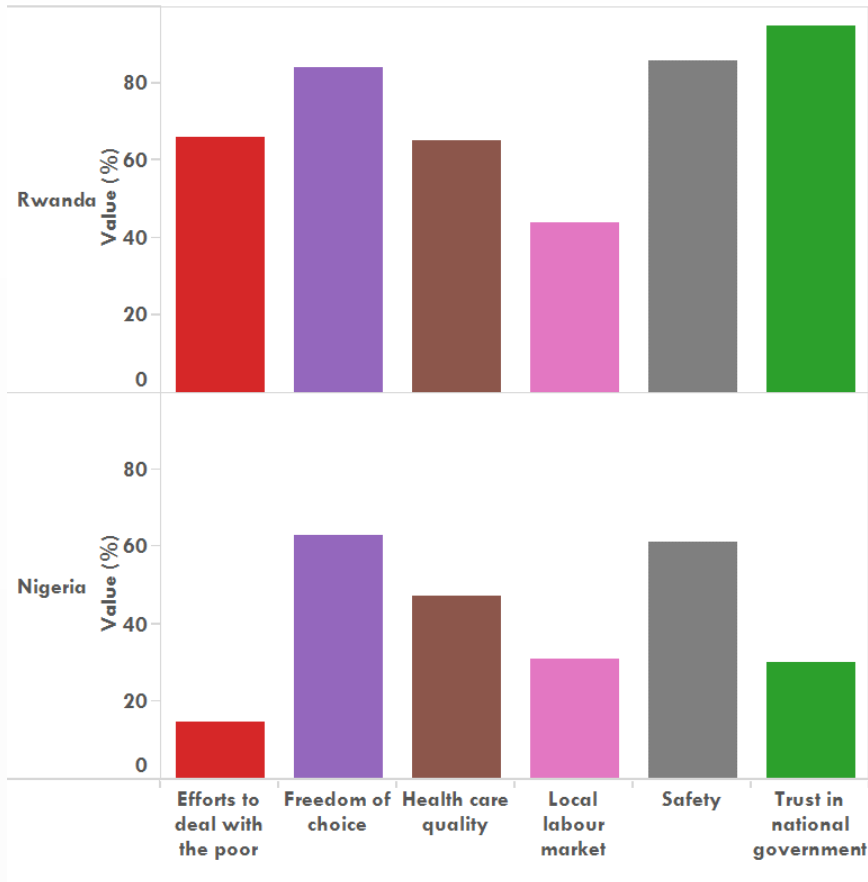

Rwanda Vs Nigeria



Look closely at those charts on the left. They compare Nigeria and Rwanda. The values show the percentages of respondents who answered on the affirmative to their perceptions on the questions used to generate the variables: efforts of the government to deal with the poor, citizens' freedom of choice, health care quality, local labour market, safety and the citizens trust in national government. The data was extracted from the recently released 2014 human development report by the UNDP. The polls was prepared by Gallup.
