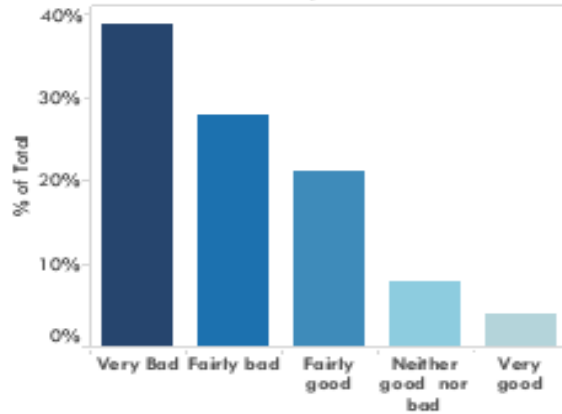
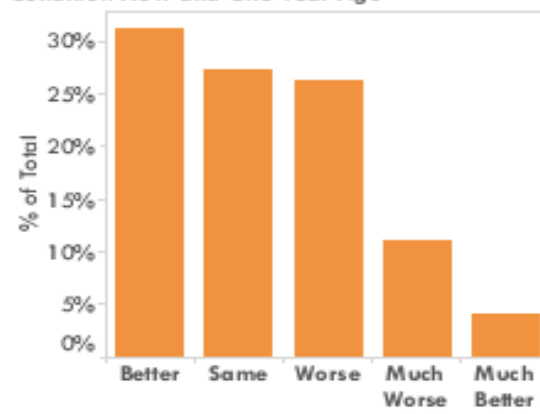

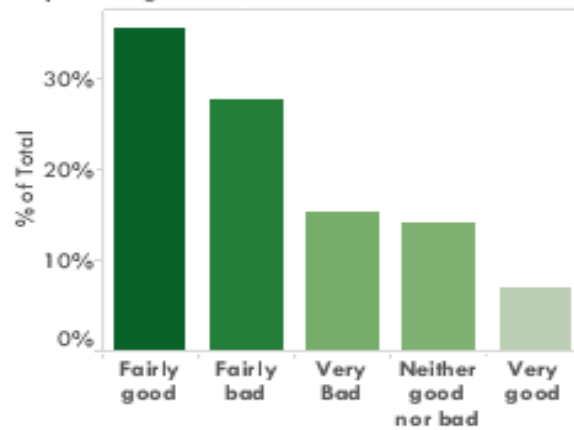
Economic Condition of the Country



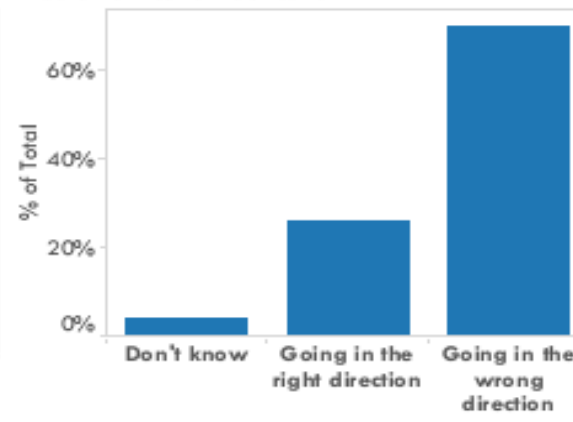
Condition Now and One Year Ago

I took the results/response summaries of some of the questions in a survey by Afrometer. The entire report is titled “Afrometer Round 5 Survey in Nigeria, 2012”. It was compiled by CLEEN Foundation and Practical Sampling International.

For the chart (on the left), “economic condition of the country” the question asked was: In general, how would you describe the present economic condition of this country? For the chart “condition now and one year ago”: Looking back, how do you rate the following compared to twelve months ago in terms of the economic conditions in this country? For the chart “Peoples living condition”: In general, how would you describe: Your own present living conditions? The data for the last chart was generated with the question: What about the overall direction of the country? Would you say that the country is going in the wrong direction or going in the right direction?

The results are very clear. On the economic condition, 67% insisted that the condition was bad. 42% opined that their condition was bad. A whopping 70% believes that we as a country are moving in the wrong direction. This study was conducted in 2012. Nevertheless, I do not think that much of the situation prevailing then has changed now.
